LOCAL LAW NO. 1

A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF HORNBY, STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO
PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN THE NUMBER OF PLANNING BOARD MEMBERS FROM
SEVEN TO FIVE

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Hornby as follows:

1. PREAMBLE AND ENACTING CLAUSE

For the purpose of providing for the orderly operation of the properties within the Town of Hornby and in order to protect and safeguard the Town of Hornby, its residents and their property with respect to certain land development within the Town, the Town Board of the Town of Hornby, Steuben County, New York, duly convened in regular session and having duly held a public hearing thereon, does hereby enact this Local Law pursuant to the authority granted under Section 271(7) of the Town Law of the State of New York.

2. TITLE

This Local Law shall be known and cited as the “Local Law 1 of 2020 of the Town of Hornby reducing the number of Planning Board members from Seven to Five.”

3. DECREASE OF MEMBERSHIP OF PLANNING BOARD

Effective immediately the number of Planning Board Members shall be reduced from Seven to Five Planning Board Members to take effect upon the expirations of the next two terms in accordance with Section 271(7) of the Town Law of the State of New York.

4. SEVERABILITY

If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Hornby hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

5. REPEALER

All parts of prior resolutions, ordinances, Local Laws and thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
