

New Dog License Fees Effective January 1, 2011

	<u>Spayed/Neutered</u>	<u>Unspayed/Unneutered</u>
1 year license fee	\$9.00	\$14.00
<i>Animal Population Control Surcharge</i>	\$1.00	\$ 3.00
<i>Total License fee</i>	\$10.00	\$17.00

This is an increase of \$6.50 for spayed/neutered and an increase of \$5.50 for unspayed/unneutered dogs.

Other Options:

2 year license fee	\$15.00	\$24.00
<i>Animal Population Control Surcharge</i>	\$2.00	\$6.00
<i>Total License Fee (2 year)</i>	17.00	\$30.00
3 year license fee	\$21.00	\$34.00
<i>Animal Population Control Surcharge</i>	\$3.00	\$9.00
<i>Total License Fee (3 year)</i>	\$24.00	43.00

Please Note – When purchasing any dog license, the rabies vaccination must be valid for at least 30 days into each year of the license.

Also, there shall be no fee paid for any license for the first dog licensed by one or more persons each of whom is aged 65 years or older.

Purebred fees:

1-10 dogs	\$50 + animal population control fee of \$3 = \$53
11-25 dogs	\$100 + animal population control fee of \$3 = \$103
26 or more dogs	\$150 + animal population control fee of \$3 = \$153
